What We've Been Up To

We've been busy over here! Here are a few of the projects we completed over the 2020–2021 school year:

- We worked with the DC Public Education Fund to develop a series of self paced, virtual courses on the science of teaching reading that are being used by K-3 teachers in the Washington, D.C. public school system.
- We developed self-paced, online courses on **blended learning** and the incorporation of technology into the ELA classroom for the Texas Education Agency (TEA). These courses are available to many teachers across Texas through the state's Community Partnerships grant program.
- We partnered with the National Charter Schools Institute to deliver professional development to teachers across Washington, D.C. on accelerating instruction.
- We're also excited to announce that The Literacy Architects has been selected as a NewSchools Venture Fund grant recipient! NewSchools grant recipients are committed to creating or expanding on innovative ways to make literacy instruction more effective for historically underserved student groups.

This grant will support our development of Literacy Masterminds, a series of virtual learning cycles through which teachers receive step-by-step asynchronous and synchronous support on implementing evidence-based literacy practices aligned with their grade-level and curriculum. We are gearing up for our first mastermind on analyzing beginning-of-year data and forming small groups with a group of first grade teachers in D.C.!
